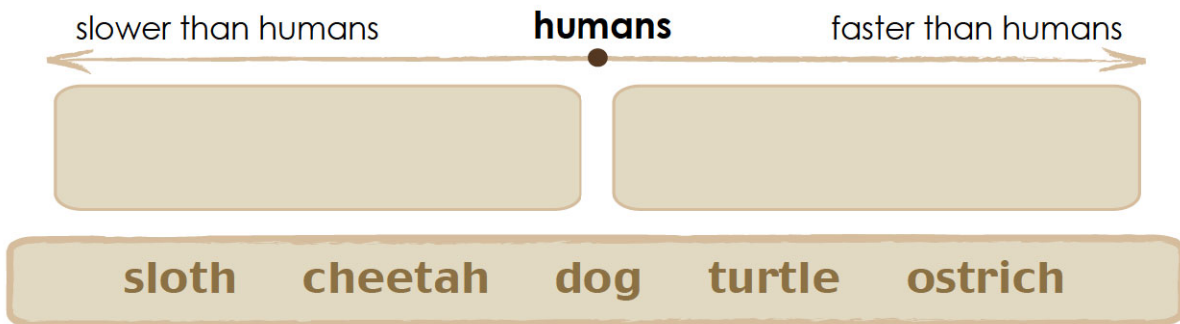




Facts about Sloths

Sloths are the world's slowest animal. They need one minute to move two meters. Here are some other facts about sloths.

Sloths live upside down in trees. They sleep and eat upside down. Mother sloths even give birth to their babies while hanging upside down! Their long, sharply curved claws help them not to fall out of the tree.

Sloths sometimes walk on the ground. They come down to go to the bathroom or to move to another tree. But they only do that once or twice a week because walking is very dangerous for them. It is easier for enemies to catch sloths on the ground. Jaguars and eagles like to eat sloths.

By the way, if you want to watch a sloth move, you will have to wait a long time. This is because sloths sleep for 18 hours a day!
